Site Visit - PAKS NPP

Day 3, Saturday - 4th of October 2014



A special highlight of the event is the visit to the Paks Nuclear Power Plant on Saturday, 04th of October 2014.

A bus, with a limited number of conference participants, will be departing from The Aquincum Hotel Budapest at 08:00 to PAKS NPP which is about 130km away from the Hotel.

During the site visit of the plant, approx. 2 hour's walk, group will be shown around the most interesting places by a professional guide. At the beginning of the program, visitors will go to the Visitor Information Centre where they will receive essential information and data regarding the plant.

The operating reactors, the main control room and the enormous turbinegenerator assemblies can be viewed from specially designed glass corridors and turbine hall can be viewed in person. The tour will end with participants being taken to the Maintenance and Training Centre which is a unique facility where real equipment, established with the assistance of the International Atomic Energy Agency, is now being used to train experts from abroad and the staff on site without the risk of radiation.

The program will be concluded with a lunch and delegates will be transferred back to The Aquincum Hotel Budapest.


